



Laserlite[®] Multiwall Polycarbonate Sheet Warranty

1. Loss of Light Transmission – 15 Year Warranty

From initial value within the first 15 years:

- The change of the yellowness index ($\Delta Y.I.$): $\Delta Y.I.$ should be less than 15 ($\Delta Y.I. < 15$) within the first fifteen years. Yellowness index is to be measured in accordance with ASTM D1925 standards. For the colour Opal, the change of yellowness index $\Delta Y.I.$ should be no more than 25 ($\Delta Y.I. < 20$) within the first fifteen years. The yellowness index is to be measured in accordance with ASTM D1925 standards.
- The decrease of light transmission ($\Delta L.T.$): for transparent Laserlite[®] multiwall polycarbonate sheet, the light should decrease by less than 11% ($\Delta L.T. < 11\%$) within the first 15 years. The light transmission is to be measured in accordance with ASTM D1003 standards.

2. Weather Breakage – 5 Year Warranty

For a period of 5 years not to break or fracture as a result of the impact of hail measuring up to 25mm in diameter at a velocity of 21m/s. Damage caused by the impact of objects other than hail is excluded from this warranty.

Subject to the matters referred to below, this Warranty applies from the original date of purchase & is valid to the original purchaser only. The benefit of the Warranty cannot be transferred to anyone else & only applies to domestic applications. This Warranty applies only to product that is stored, installed & cleaned in accordance with Mulford Building Products recommendations. This Warranty does not apply to any sheet which has been scratched or similarly damaged whether by accident, vandalism, fire or other like causes. The Warranty does not apply if any sheet has not been cleaned in accordance with Mulford Building Products recommendations & in particular, if loss of light transmission has been caused by accumulation of dirt or use of chemicals, paint or other substances. This Warranty does not cover installation or related expenses or any other direct or indirect loss(es) which may result from product failure & Mulford Building Products will not by virtue of this Warranty be liable in contract or in tort for any consequential indirect or special damage or loss of any kind whatever. All claims made under this Warranty must be notified to Mulford Building Products in writing & be accompanied by proof of purchase as specified below. Following inspection of the failed product by an authorised Mulford Building Products representative the failed sheet should be returned to Mulford Building Products. Prior to measuring the light transmission & impact resistance, the product must be cleaned in accordance with Mulford Building Products recommendations so the tests referred to above can be carried out. All claims made pursuant to this Warranty should be made in writing to the Business Development Manager, Mulford Building Products, Unit 1/ Oakdale Close, Horsley Park NSW 2175 & should include a copy of the original purchase documentation or reasonable evidence of the original purchase date. Unless & to the extent expressly prohibited by legislation such as the Trade Practices Act 1974 which cannot be excluded or modified, the liability of Mulford Building Products for a breach of any condition or warranty shall be limited to the replacement of the failed sheet or to the supply of an equivalent product or to the cost of replacing the failed product or of acquiring an equivalent product.
